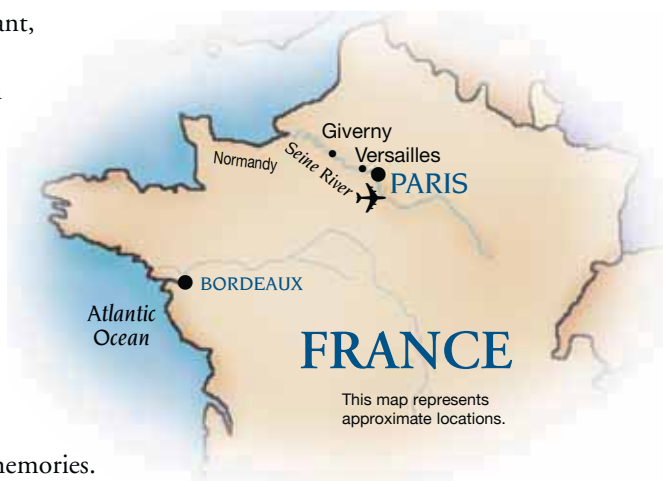

FRIDAY, APRIL 27

Paris – Included sightseeing

This morning's panoramic drive of **Paris** will take you past the legendary sights the city is famous for: the Champs-Élysées and Arc de Triomphe, Les Invalides (Napoleon's resting place), the Place de la Concorde, and of course, the Eiffel Tower. Later, visit **Montmartre**, an area that attracts singers, writers, and painters from everywhere and home to the magnificent Sacré-Coeur Basilica. **(B)**

In the afternoon, go **behind the scenes at the Eiffel Tower** to discover the secrets behind the "Iron Lady." Enter the impressive engine room, which still controls the elevators, see the former military bunker hidden under the Champ de Mars, and stroll along the first floor's technical gallery as you admire the amazing views.

Next, sample **wine and cheese at the Musée du Vin**, the 15th-century cellars originally built as part of a monastery. The cellars were later renovated and used for wine storage by the Eiffel Tower's restaurant, before becoming a museum. Now owned by the Conseil des Echantons de France, a world-class authority on wine, the museum offers guests a privileged opportunity to taste wine and cheese in the company of a true expert.

SATURDAY, APRIL 28

Paris – Included sightseeing

Browse one of the largest art collections in the world with a visit to the **Louvre Museum**. This former royal palace and fortress is home to many masterpieces, including the famous *Mona Lisa*, the *Winged Victory of Samothrace*, and the beautiful *Venus de Milo*. Continue to the largest cathedral in Paris, **Notre-Dame**, the building that epitomizes the city's history. The first stone was laid in 1163 and construction continued over many centuries, resulting in the Gothic masterpiece we see today with its legendary flying buttresses, menacing gargoyles, and beautifully proportioned west façade. **(B)**

After lunch on your own, continue to the **Palais Garnier**, the largest opera house in Europe. Designed by Charles Garnier in 1878, this baroque building stands as an embodiment of artistic style during the Second Empire. Unravel the intrigue of this amazing opera house through the legend of the Phantom and other scandalous tales. Witness its architectural splendor as you take in the majestic Grand Staircase, the Gallery, the Rotonde du Glacier, and the Grand Foyer, noted for Baudry's distinctly beautiful panels.





SUNDAY, APRIL 29

Paris

Day at leisure OR **OPTIONAL Versailles, Giverny & Monet's House** excursion. Begin the day with an unforgettable visit to one of the most magnificent palaces in the world, Versailles. See the awe-inspiring Hall of Mirrors, scene of the signing of the 1919 peace treaty that ended World War I, and explore the sumptuous royal suites, whose 1662 décor is still intact. Then follow the Seine to Giverny to visit Claude Monet's charming house and spectacular gardens. Stand in the garden where he painted his masterpieces, walk through his studio, and see the famous Japanese bridge. It's an art lover's dream! **(B)**

MONDAY, APRIL 30

Paris

Day at leisure OR **OPTIONAL Cooking Class at L'Atelier des Sens**. There is no better place to learn Parisian cuisine than in Paris itself! After honing your culinary skills with instruction from an expert at L'Atelier des Sens, enjoy an included lunch. Afternoon at leisure. **(B)**

OPTIONAL Dinner in the Eiffel Tower at *58 Tour Eiffel*, a restaurant that offers stunning panoramas on one side and a unique view of the Tower's interior on the other.

TUESDAY, MAY 1

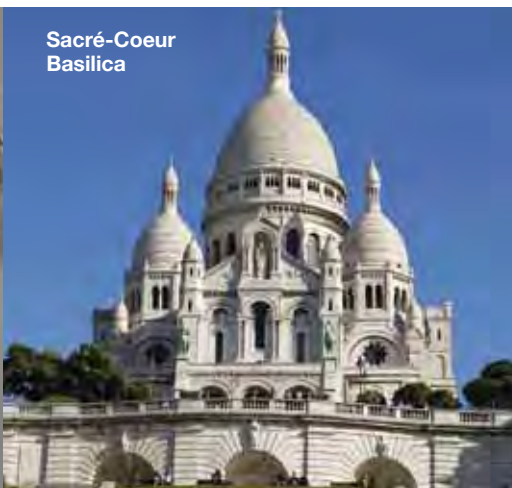
