Founding:

The Black Alumni Chapter was established on March 15, 2011 by co-founders Barbara Brown Simmons and Sam W.D. Johnson, University of New Mexico Law School graduates in 1974 and 1976.

Purpose:

The purpose of the UNM Black Alumni Chapter is to develop a plan to mobilize the membership to assist in the accomplishment of the organization's purpose as follows:

- To establish contact between the University and its Black Alumni
- To maintain the existence of the Africana Studies Program and the African American Student Center
- To assist with the recruitment, retention and graduation of Black Students
- To establish a historical archive of the Black Student movement and the Black Alumni contribution locally, nationally and internationally
- To establish the Josephus (Joe) Long Scholarship at the University of New Mexico
- To establish a bi-annual University of New Mexico Black Alumni publication

Josephus Long Scholarship Fund:

The Josephus (Joe) Long Scholarship Fund is named in honor of Josephus (Joe) Long, the first Black Student Union President at UNM in 1967. The purpose of the scholarship fund is to honor Joe for his leadership and commitment to equality in the field of education for Black students. He attended the University of New Mexico from the fall of 1967 to the fall of 1969. His major was Art Education. He received a Master of Arts degree from the University of New Mexico on June 3, 1970.
